

DESCRIPTION

This course consists of didactic presentations and small group workshops to keep pediatricians, family practitioners and other child health clinicians up-to-date on a number of clinical practice recommendations relevant to pediatric primary care. Some of the topics to be covered include: childhood obesity; sleep disorders; vaping and lung injury; firearm injury prevention; HIV prevention; gender affirming care; concussions; depression and suicide; behavioral health emergencies; immunizations; atopic dermatitis; hypertension; sports injuries and much more.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This activity is intended for pediatricians, family practitioners, nurse practitioners and physician assistants involved in providing primary care for infants, children and adolescents

OBIECTIVES

After attending this activity, the learner will demonstrate the ability to:

- Discuss the latest immunization recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).
- Perform a comprehensive approach to managing children and adolescents with overweight and obesity, based on the 2023 AAP Clinical Practice Guideline.
- · Discuss harm reduction strategies for families to prevent firearmrelated injuries and deaths.
- Identify effective ways to discuss health risks associated with cannabis use with adolescents.
- Recognize indications for offering Pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) and post-exposure prophylaxis (PEP) for preventing HIV.
