Description

The goal of this activity is to educate primary care providers to enhance basic skills and competencies in evaluation and management of common ambulatory musculoskeletal (MSK) complaints. In this activity, our approach is multidisciplinary and comprehensive, with speakers from rheumatology, orthopedics, spine, sports medicine, physical and occupational therapy. Hence, we aim to bring together expertise from different fields of MSK medicine to focus on 1) what is new in this field, 2) how to improve patient care and clinical outcomes and 3) finally, how to enhance provider skills and confidence.

Who Should Attend

Primary Care Physicians, Community Physicians, Family Practitioners, Nurses, Physical and Occupational Therapists, and Physician Extenders.

Objectives

After attending this activity, the participant will demonstrate the ability to:

- Differentiate inflammatory from non-inflammatory joint and back complaints.
- Design a key diagnostic workup of MSK conditions, including the need for orthopedic, rheumatology, or sports medicine referral.
- Describe basic principles of diagnosis and management of back pain, inflammatory arthritis and osteoarthritis, soft tissue rheumatism, and common orthopedic issues.
- Identify the role of physical and occupational therapy in MSK conditions.
- Discuss the role of pain management in MSK conditions.
