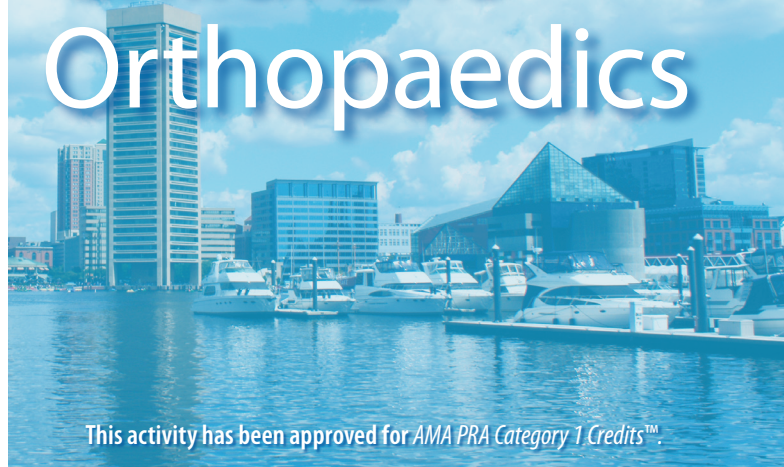

## DESCRIPTION

This one day course will address common pediatric musculoskeletal conditions and will provide a forum to discuss office management and referral criteria in order to enhance the care of pediatric patients locally. Small group educational sessions will be offered to address the educational need of the target audience.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This activity is intended for pediatricians, family practitioners, orthopaedic surgeons, nurse practitioners, physician assistants, physical therapists, nurses, certified medical assistants, orthopaedic fellows and residents.

## OBJECTIVES

After attending this activity, the participant will demonstrate the ability to:

- Identify the use of MAGEC rods in the treatment of spinal deformity.
- Recognize the clinical presentation and treatment options for hip impingement.
- Identify common hand injuries among pediatric patients.
- Recognize the common components of a hallway gait analysis.
- Recognize the use of DME and/or braces in the treatment of sports injuries.
- Identify radiologic findings of patients with spine deformities.
