

DESCRIPTION

This course consists of didactic presentations and small group workshops to keep pediatricians, family practitioners and other child health clinicians up-to-date on a number of clinical practice recommendations and topics that are relevant to pediatric and adolescent primary care. Some of the topics to be covered include: COVID19; screening for sexually transmitted infections; sports injuries; childhood obesity; type 2 diabetes; concussions; asthma; depression; gender affirming care for transgender youth; substance use disorders; common dermatology issues and more.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This activity is intended for pediatricians, family practitioners, nurse practitioners and physician assistants involved in providing primary care for infants, children and adolescents.

OBJECTIVES

After attending this activity, the learner will demonstrate the ability to:

- Discuss the latest immunization recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).
- Recognize the indications for referring a child with a heart murmur to a pediatric cardiologist.
- Discuss the latest practice guidelines from the American Academy of Pediatrics.
- Identify the appropriate physical examination maneuvers in assessing common sports injuries.
- Discuss strategies for discussing gender identity and approaches for providing gender-affirming care.
