DESCRIPTION

The advancements in treatment options for thyroid and parathyroid disease has resulted in removing less and preserving more. This course will provide up-to-date information regarding treatment options including transoral thyroidectomy and radiofrequency ablation of benign thyroid nodules for patients with thyroid and parathyroid disease. The course is focused around these novel treatment modalities in an effort to provide knowledge and hands on teaching for safe delivery of state-of-the-art care for patients.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This activity is intended for general surgery, endocrinology, otolaryngology and radiology.

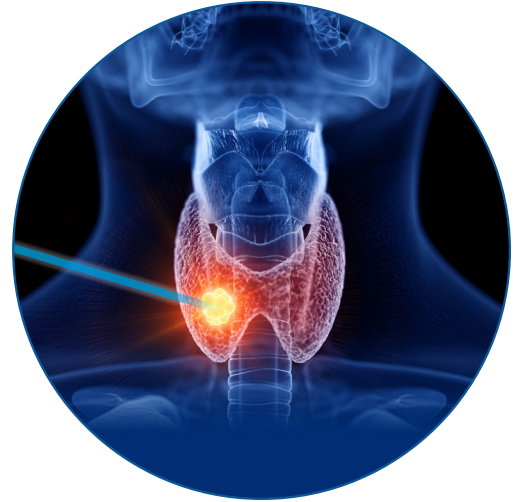
