DESCRIPTION

This course consists of didactic presentations and small group workshops to keep pediatricians, family practitioners and other child health clinicians up-to-date on a number of clinical practice recommendations relevant to pediatric primary care. Some of the topics to be covered include: treatment of pediatric obesity; autism; long COVID19; Food Allergies; managing febrile infants; gender affirming care; GI functional disorders; depression and suicide; migraine updates; immunizations; substance use disorders; hypertension; Breast feeding basics and much more.
